"* **Sec. 45.** AS 15.20.910 is amended to read:

Sec. 15.20.910. Standards for voting machines and vote tally systems. The director may approve a voting machine or vote tally system for use in an election in the state upon consideration of factors relevant to the administration of state elections. A [, INCLUDING WHETHER THE FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION HAS CERTIFIED THE VOTING MACHINE OR VOTE TALLY SYSTEM TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE VOTING SYSTEM STANDARDS APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION AS REQUIRED BY 42 U.S.C. 15481(a)(5) (HELP AMERICA VOTE ACT OF 2002). THE DIRECTOR MAY ONLY APPROVE A] voting machine or vote tally system **must meet the United States Election Assistance Commission's voluntary voting system guidelines and be certified by the commission, have open-source software technology, and satisfy** [IF THE MACHINE OR SYSTEM SATISFIES] the requirements of AS 15.15.032(c). **In this section, "open-source software technology" means the complete source code for the software is available to the public, under the terms of a license, to use, modify, or distribute freely without payment of royalties or other consideration.**
