1 "An Act relating to the definition of 'political party'; and providing for an effective

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 15.80.010(27) is amended to read:

5	(27) "political party" means an organized group of voters that has at
6	least 5,000 registered voters in the state; beginning with the results of the 2030
7	decennial federal census, following each decennial federal census, the division
8	shall by regulation adjust this number by the percentage of the change to the
9	population of the state since the 2020 decennial federal census, rounded to the
10	nearest 500 [REPRESENTS A POLITICAL PROGRAM AND
11	(A) THAT HAS REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE STATE
12	EQUAL IN NUMBER TO AT LEAST THREE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL
13	VOTES CAST FOR GOVERNOR AT THE PRECEDING GENERAL
14	ELECTION;

(B) IF THE OFFICE OF GOVERNOR WAS NOT ON THE
BALLOT AT THE PRECEDING GENERAL ELECTION BUT THE OFFICE
OF UNITED STATES SENATOR WAS ON THAT BALLOT, THAT HAS
REGISTERED VOTERS IN THE STATE EQUAL IN NUMBER TO AT
LEAST THREE PERCENT OF THE TOTAL VOTES CAST FOR UNITED
STATES SENATOR AT THAT GENERAL ELECTION; OR
(C) IF NEITHER THE OFFICE OF GOVERNOR NOR THE

8OFFICE OF UNITED STATES SENATOR WAS ON THE BALLOT AT9THE PRECEDING GENERAL ELECTION, THAT HAS REGISTERED10VOTERS IN THE STATE EQUAL IN NUMBER TO AT LEAST THREE11PERCENT OF THE TOTAL VOTES CAST FOR UNITED STATES12REPRESENTATIVE AT THAT GENERAL ELECTION];

13 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.
