The Study

Goals

Update and expand knowledge about sex offender recidivism in Alaska

Objectives

- 1. Provide **updated estimates** (2016) of Alaska sex offender recidivism.
- 2. Expand post-incarceration follow-up period **from 2 to 7 years** in order to better understand sex offender **desistance**.
- 3. Use group-based trajectory modeling (GTM) techniques to examine **potential differences** among sex offenders in the **frequency** and **intensity** of post-incarceration reoffending.




The Data

- Alaska Department of Corrections
 - Sample of offenders (n=406)
 - Convicted of one or more qualifying sex offenses
 - Sentenced to a period of incarceration in ADOC facility
 - Released between January 1, 2006 and December 31, 2008
- Alaska Department of Public Safety
 - Criminal history data
 - Arrests and convictions



Key Findings


Sex Offender Recidivism Cumulative Rate – View 1



Length of Time Following Release from Prison




Sex Offender Recidivism Cumulative Rate – View 2





Sex Offender RecidivismTrajectory Groups – View 3



Length of Time Following Release from Prison (years)

− − · Group 1 (24.0%) — Group 2 (54.0%) — Group 3 (15.3%) — Group 4 (6.7%)



Summary

- Sex offenders recidivate at markedly lower rates than those convicted of other offenses
- Sex offenders are infrequently rearrested or reconvicted for the commission of new sex offenses
- Sex offenders are less likely to reoffend over time (in general see below)
- Sex offenders recidivate at different rates, and these rates vary over time
