FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act extending the termination date of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska;
- 2 relating to Regulatory Commission of Alaska regulations regarding refuse utilities;
- 3 relating to the powers and duties of the legislative audit division; and providing for an
- 4 effective date."
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
- 7 to read:
- 8 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the legislature that the Regulatory
- 9 Commission of Alaska shall adopt regulations authorized under sec. 2 of this Act that are
- specific to refuse utilities and that provide for sufficient public notice and time for ratepayers
- 11 to meaningfully comment on rate filings.
- * **Sec. 2.** AS 42.05.381(e) is amended to read:
- 13 (e) The commission shall adopt regulations for electric cooperatives, [AND
- FOR] local exchange telephone utilities, and refuse utilities, setting a range for

1	adjustment of rates by a simplified rate filing procedure. A cooperative ₂ [OR]
2	telephone utility, or refuse utility may apply for permission to adjust its rates over a
3	period of time under the simplified rate filing procedure regulations. The commission
4	shall grant the application if the cooperative, [OR] telephone utility, or refuse utility
5	satisfies the requirements of the regulations. The commission may review
6	implementation of the simplified rate filing procedure at reasonable intervals and may
7	revoke permission to use the procedure or require modification of the rates to correct
8	an error.
