SENATE BILL 20 *Teacher Certificate Reciprocity*

SUMMARY of CHANGES *(from version G to W)*

Change #1

Section 2, page 2, line 11, added:

“...hold a valid regular teacher certificate issued by another state;”

Explanation: For teachers coming into Alaska seeking a reciprocal teaching certificate, to clarify they have a valid certificate issued by state they are coming from, achieved in a traditional manner, to include completion of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited higher education institution, supervised clinical practice such as student teaching, and a program of study in teaching methodologies.

Change #2

Section 4, page 2, line 30-31, added:

“...contain the same endorsements as those on the current valid regular teacher certificate issues by the other state.”

Explanation: For conformity with Change #1 described above.
