## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

#### STATE OF ALASKA 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 120

#### Analysis

This bill authorizes the Department of Education & Early Development (DEED) to transfer real property to a broader group of entities. It amends AS 14.07.030(a)(6) by removing the limitation on the entities that DEED has authority to transfer real property to. Currently, DEED is limited to transfer interests in land to federal agencies, state agencies, or to political subdivisions.

There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Education and Early Development as a result of this legislation.

This bill has an immediate effective date.
