Delete "The director shall, within 48 hours, but in no event later than five days after election day, send a notice of deficiency by first class, nonforwardable mail to the address indicated in the voter's registration record and by electronic mail to the voter's electronic mail address if the voter has provided an electronic mail address. If the voter has provided a telephone number, the director shall attempt to notify the voter of the deficiency by telephone call or text message to the voter's telephone number."

Insert "The director shall, within 24 hours, send a notice of deficiency by electronic mail, telephone call, or text message to the voter's electronic mail address or telephone number if the voter has provided an electronic mail address or telephone number. The director shall attempt to notify the voter by electronic mail, telephone call, or text message once a day throughout the 14-day ballot cure period or until the ballot has been cured, whichever comes first. If a voter has provided both an electronic mail address and a telephone number, the director may choose to contact the voter by electronic mail, telephone call, or text message. The director shall, within five days after election day, send a notice of deficiency by first class, nonforwardable mail to the address indicated in the voter's registration record. The mailed notice must include directions for accessing language assistance."
