3 "(r) If the commissioner reserves a public easement or right-of-way under (p) 4 of this section on or across land to be disposed of under this section, the commissioner 5 shall sell the land subject to a perpetual covenant that runs with the land, for the benefit of all residents of the state, that requires the owner of the land to mark and 6 7 maintain a reserved public easement or right-of-way on or across the land in a manner 8 that allows the public to easily recognize and use the public easement or right-of-way. 9 The attorney general or an aggrieved person may institute a civil action, including an 10 action for injunctive relief, against a person who fails to mark or maintain a public 11 easement or right-of-way as required by this subsection."

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
