In response to Rep. Foster's SB 243 related question during the House Finance Committee hearing on 5/9/2022:

Total FY2021 PCE Eligible kWh (Col G) = 97,281,383 kWh

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Total Proposed PCE Max kWh (750 kWh, Col K) = 251,262,000 kWh

= 39% = Total FY2021 Eligible kWh as a percentage of the proposed increased Maximum eligible PCE kWh for current PCE communities.
