A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the interview requirements of the State Medical Board."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 08.64.255 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.64.255. **INTERVIEWS. An applicant** [INTERVIEW REQUIRED. ALL APPLICANTS] for licensure may [SHALL] be interviewed in person by [AT LEAST ONE MEMBER OF] the board **or by a member of the board** before a license **is** [WILL BE] issued. The interview must be recorded. If the application is denied on the basis of the interview, the denial **shall** [MUST] be stated in writing, with the reasons for it, and the record **shall** [MUST] be preserved.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 08.64.279 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.64.279. INTERVIEW [REQUIRED] FOR PERMITS. An applicant for an intern permit, a resident permit, or a temporary permit for locum tenens practice **may** [SHALL] be interviewed in person by **the board, a** [AT LEAST ONE] member of the board, the executive secretary of the board, or a person designated for that purpose by the board.
