1 Relating to overtaking and passing certain stationary vehicles.

3 * **Section 1.** AS 28.35.185(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) The driver of a vehicle that approaches a stationary emergency vehicle,
5 fire vehicle, [OR] law enforcement vehicle, tow truck in the act of picking up a
6 vehicle, or animal control vehicle being used to perform official duties, when the
7 stationary vehicle is displaying flashing emergency lights on a highway or roadway

8 (1) with two or more lanes traveling in the same direction, unless
9 otherwise directed by law enforcement or emergency personnel, shall safely vacate the
10 lane closest to the emergency vehicle, fire vehicle, [OR] law enforcement vehicle, tow
11 truck in the act of picking up a vehicle, or animal control vehicle being used to
12 perform official duties; or

13 (2) unless otherwise directed by law enforcement or emergency
14 personnel, shall slow to a reasonable and prudent speed considering the traffic,
15 roadway, and weather conditions.
