BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

1 Relating to participation in certain student fellowships as an allowable absence from the state
2 for purposes of eligibility for permanent fund dividends; and providing for an effective date.

4 * **Section 1.** AS 43.23.008(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) Subject to (b) and (c) of this section, an otherwise eligible individual who
6 is absent from the state during the qualifying year remains eligible for a current year
7 permanent fund dividend if the individual was absent

8 (1) receiving secondary or postsecondary education on a full-time
9 basis;

10 (2) receiving vocational, professional, or other specific education on a
11 full-time basis for which, as determined by the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary
12 Education, a comparable program is not reasonably available in the state;

13 (3) serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the

United States or accompanying, as that individual's spouse, minor dependent, or disabled dependent, an individual who is

(A) serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States; and

(B) eligible for a current year dividend;

(4) serving under foreign or coastal articles of employment aboard an oceangoing vessel of the United States merchant marine;

(5) receiving continuous medical treatment recommended by a licensed physician or convalescing as recommended by the physician who treated the illness if the treatment or convalescence is not based on a need for climatic change;

(6) providing care for a parent, spouse, sibling, child, or stepchild with a critical life-threatening illness whose treatment plan, as recommended by the attending physician, requires travel outside the state for treatment at a medical specialty complex;

(7) providing care for the individual's terminally ill family member;

(8) settling the estate of the individual's deceased parent, spouse, sibling, child, or stepchild, provided the absence does not exceed 220 cumulative days;

(9) serving as a member of the United States Congress;

(10) serving on the staff of a member from this state of the United States Congress;

(11) serving as an employee of the state in a field office or other location;

(12) accompanying a minor who is absent under (5) of this subsection;

(13) accompanying another eligible resident who is absent for a reason permitted under (1), (2), (5) - (12), [OR] (16), or (17) of this subsection as the spouse, minor dependent, or disabled dependent of the eligible resident;

(14) serving as a volunteer in the federal peace corps program;

(15) because of training or competing as a member of the United States Olympic Team;

(16) participating for educational purposes in a student fellowship sponsored by the United States Department of Education or by the United States

1 **Department of State;**

2 (17) for any reason consistent with the individual's intent to remain a
3 state resident, provided the absence or cumulative absences do not exceed

4 (A) 180 days in addition to any absence or cumulative absences
5 claimed under (3) of this subsection if the individual is not claiming an absence
6 under (1), (2), or (4) - (16) [(4) - (15)] of this subsection;

7 (B) 120 days in addition to any absence or cumulative absences
8 claimed under (1) - (3) of this subsection if the individual is not claiming an
9 absence under (4) - (16) [(4) - (15)] of this subsection but is claiming an
10 absence under (1) or (2) of this subsection; or

11 (C) 45 days in addition to any absence or cumulative absences
12 claimed under (1) - (16) [(1) - (15)] of this subsection if the individual is
13 claiming an absence under (4) - (16) [(4) - (15)] of this subsection.

14 * **Sec. 2.** AS 43.23.008(b) is amended to read:

15 (b) An individual may not claim an allowable absence under (a)(1) - (16)
16 [(a)(1) - (15)] of this section unless the individual was a resident of the state for at
17 least six consecutive months immediately before leaving the state.

18 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
19 read:

20 PERMANENT FUND DIVIDEND APPLICATIONS. Notwithstanding permanent
21 fund dividend application procedures or deadlines, an individual who qualifies for a dividend
22 for 2006, 2007, or 2008 because of the amendment to AS 43.23.008(a) made in sec. 1 of this
23 Act may apply for the dividend by September 15, 2008. The Department of Revenue shall
24 prepare a form for applications under this section.

25 * **Sec. 4.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
26 read:

27 RETROACTIVITY. The amendments to AS 43.23.008(a) and (b) made in secs. 1 and
28 2 of this Act are retroactive to January 1, 2005.

29 * **Sec. 5.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
