4 * **Section 1.** AS 24.60.075(c) is amended to read:

5 (c) [A LEGISLATOR OR LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE MAY NOT
6 SOLICIT, ACCEPT, OR RECEIVE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY,
7 COMPASSIONATE GIFTS WORTH LESS THAN \$250 THAT IN A CALENDAR
8 YEAR AGGREGATE TO \$250 OR MORE IN VALUE AND ARE FROM THE
9 SAME PERSON.] A legislator or legislative employee who receives a compassionate
10 gift, directly or indirectly, shall disclose to the committee the name of the gift's source
11 and the value of the gift within 30 days after receipt.

12 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
