4                   **Sec. 10.50.010. Authorized purposes.** A limited liability company may be  
5                   organized under this chapter for any lawful purpose, including the rendering of a  
6                   professional service.

7 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 10.50.150(c) is amended to read:

8                   (c) Notwithstanding (a) and (b) of this section, and unless otherwise provided  
9                   [ANOTHER LEVEL OF MEMBER CONSENT IS REQUIRED] in an operating  
10                  agreement of the company or in the company's articles of organization, the written  
11                  consent of all of the members of a limited liability company is required to  
12                  (1) amend the articles of organization;  
13                  (2) amend an operating agreement of the company; or  
14                  (3) authorize a manager or member to perform an act on behalf of the  
15                  company that contravenes an operating agreement of the company, including an act

that contravenes a provision of the operating agreement that expressly limits the purposes, affairs, or conduct of the affairs of the company.

(18) "professional service" has the meaning given in AS 10.45.500.
