**A RESOLUTION**

1    **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**  
2    **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 111, relating to the oil and gas production tax,**  
3    **tax payments, and credits; relating to interest applicable to delinquent oil and gas**  
4    **production tax; relating to carried-forward lease expenditures based on losses and**  
5    **limiting those lease expenditures to an amount equal to the gross value at the point of**  
6    **production of oil and gas produced from the lease or property where the lease**  
7    **expenditure was incurred; relating to information concerning tax credits, lease**  
8    **expenditures, and oil and gas taxes; relating to the disclosure of that information to the**  
9    **public; relating to an adjustment in the gross value at the point of production; and**  
10   **relating to a legislative working group.**

11    **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

12        That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of  
13   Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding

1 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 111, relating to  
2 the oil and gas production tax, tax payments, and credits; relating to interest applicable to  
3 delinquent oil and gas production tax; relating to carried-forward lease expenditures based on  
4 losses and limiting those lease expenditures to an amount equal to the gross value at the point  
5 of production of oil and gas produced from the lease or property where the lease expenditure  
6 was incurred; relating to information concerning tax credits, lease expenditures, and oil and  
7 gas taxes; relating to the disclosure of that information to the public; relating to an adjustment  
8 in the gross value at the point of production; and relating to a legislative working group.
