FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to referrals involving dental services."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

5	REVOCATION OF LICENSE. The board may revoke or suspend the license of a
6	dentist, or may reprimand, censure, or discipline a dentist, or both, if the board finds
