## A BILL

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act changing the date that the legislature convenes in the years following
- 2 a gubernatorial election; changing the date that the term of a member of the
- 3 legislature begins in the years following a gubernatorial election."
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- **Section 1.** AS 24.05.080 is amended to read:
- Sec. 24.05.080. TERMS. The term of each member of the legislature begins on the second Monday in January following a presidential election year; however, following a gubernatorial election year, the term of each member begins on the third <a href="Tuesday">Tuesday</a> [MONDAY] in January. The term of representatives is two years, and the term of senators is four years. One-half of the senators shall be elected every two

- Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene at the capital each year on the second Monday in January at 10:00 a.m.; however, following

1	a gubernatorial election year, the legislature shall convene on the third $\underline{Tuesday}$
2	[MONDAY] in January at 10:00 a.m. Except as provided in this section, each
3	legislature shall have a duration of two years and shall consist of a "First Regular
4	Session," which shall meet in the odd-numbered years, and a "Second Regular
5	Session," which shall meet in the even-numbered years, and any special session or
6	sessions that [WHICH] the governor or legislature may find necessary to call.
