A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the interview requirements of the State Medical Board."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * **Section 1.** AS 08.64.255 is amended to read:

4 Sec. 08.64.255. **INTERVIEWS. An applicant** [INTERVIEW REQUIRED.
5 ALL APPLICANTS] for licensure **may** [SHALL] be interviewed in person by [AT
6 LEAST ONE MEMBER OF] the board **or by a member of the board** before a
7 license **is** [WILL BE] issued. The interview must be recorded. If the application is
8 denied on the basis of the interview, the denial **shall** [MUST] be stated in writing, with
9 the reasons for it, and the record **shall** [MUST] be preserved.

10 * **Sec. 2.** AS 08.64.279 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 08.64.279. INTERVIEW [REQUIRED] FOR PERMITS. An applicant
12 for an intern permit, a resident permit, or a temporary permit for locum tenens practice
13 **may** [SHALL] be interviewed in person by **the board, a** [AT LEAST ONE] member
14 of the board, the executive secretary of the board, or a person designated for that
15 purpose by the board.
