A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to false statements and omissions in regard to application for
2 fish and game licenses, tags, and permits and to nonresident hunters."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 16.05.420(b) is repealed and reenacted to read:

5 (b) A person may not make a false statement, or omit a material fact, in an
6 application for a license, tag, or permit issued under AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.430. A
7 person who without any culpable mental state makes a false statement as to the
8 person's identity or residency in an application for a license, tag, or permit issued
9 under AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.430 is guilty of a violation and upon conviction is
10 punishable by a fine of not more than \$300. A person who knowingly violates this
11 subsection is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

12 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.05.430(a) is amended to read:

13 (a) Except as provided in AS 16.05.407(b) and (d), 16.05.408(b), and
14 16.05.420(b) [AS 16.05.420(b)], a person who violates AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.420 or

1 a regulation adopted under AS 16.05.330 - 16.05.420 is guilty of a misdemeanor and
2 upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment
3 for not more than six months, or by both.
