A RESOLUTION

1 Suspending Uniform Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e) of the Alaska State
2 Legislature concerning House Bill No. 292, relating to searches by peace officers
3 who enforce fish and game laws, to false statements and omissions in regard to
4 application for fish and game licenses, tags, and permits, and to nonresident
5 hunters.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 That under Rule 54 of the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the
8 provisions of Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e) of the Uniform Rules, regarding changes to the
9 title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 292, relating to searches by
10 peace officers who enforce fish and game laws, to false statements and omissions in regard
11 to application for fish and game licenses, tags, and permits, and to nonresident hunters.
