- 5 house may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other house concurs; and
- 6 WHEREAS Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that
- 7 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house
- 8 constitutes concurrence;
- 9 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of
- 10 Representatives may be in recess during March 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of 1996 and that each house
- 11 concurs in this five-day recess by the other.
