A RESOLUTION

1 Disapproving Executive Order No. 95.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 WHEREAS the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State
4 of Alaska, has proposed in Executive Order No. 95 to transfer the responsibility for the
5 licensing and regulating of big game guides and related occupations to the Department of
6 Commerce and Economic Development; and

7 WHEREAS art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that unless
8 disapproved within 60 days of a regular session by resolution concurred in by a majority of
9 the members of the legislature in joint session, an executive order becomes effective at a date
10 designated by the governor;

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No. 95 is
12 disapproved.
