1 Disapproving Executive Order No. 97.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 WHEREAS the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State
- 4 of Alaska, has proposed in Executive Order No. 97 transferring functions of the Alaska
- 5 Commission on Postsecondary Education to the Department of Education and to the Alaska
- 6 Student Loan Corporation, renaming the corporation the Alaska Student Aid Corporation and
- 7 placing it under the Department of Revenue; and
- **8 WHEREAS** art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that unless
- 9 disapproved within 60 days of a regular session by resolution concurred in by a majority of
- 10 the members of the legislature in joint session, an executive order becomes effective at a date
- **11** designated by the governor;
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No. 97 is
- disapproved.
