- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * Section 1. AS 47.07.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 6 (h) A person who meets the eligibility requirements of (a) or (b) of this section, except that the person is a qualified alien as defined in 8 U.S.C. 1641, is
- 8 eligible for medical assistance unless the person is not eligible under the limited
- **9** eligibility provision of 8 U.S.C. 1613.
- * Sec. 2. AS 47.25.430 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 11 (f) Unless the person is not eligible under the limited eligibility provision of
- 8 U.S.C. 1613, a state payment under AS 47.25.430 47.25.615 shall be made to a
- person who
- 14 (1) meets the requirements of state law;

2	(3) otherwise meets the eligibility requirements of 42 U.S.C. 1381 -

9	this chapter if the person is not precluded by the limited eligibility provision of 8
