A **RESOLUTION**

1 Creating the Deferred Maintenance Task Force.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the maintenance costs for public facilities represent a significant expense
of state government; and

5 WHEREAS a substantial amount of maintenance costs for public facilities have been
6 deferred from previous years; and

7 **WHEREAS** these deferred maintenance costs should be addressed in a comprehensive 8 manner that gives due regard both to the importance of preserving the value of the facilities 9 with proper maintenance and to the restricted availability of funds to meet maintenance needs; 10 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature establishes the Deferred 11 Maintenance Task Force to make recommendations to the Governor and the legislature on how 12 to address the deferred maintenance needs of public facilities, including transportation 13 facilities, educational facilities, and the other types of public facilities described and defined 14 in AS 44.42.055; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall consist of the following ten voting16 members:

(1) five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker

of the House; at least one member shall be a member of the majority and at least one a 1 member of the minority; and 2

3 (2) five members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate; at 4 least one member shall be a member of the majority and at least one a member of the 5 minority; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force includes the Speaker of the House of 7 Representatives and the President of the Senate as nonvoting members; and be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall select a chair and vice-chair from 9 among its members, shall meet as frequently as the task force determines necessary to perform 10 its work, may meet during the interim, and may meet and vote by teleconference; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall

(1)review and evaluate state policy and strategy recommendations and 13 assumptions from reports and publications from similar efforts in the past made by the 14 executive branch, the legislative branch, and other public and private individuals and 15 organizations;

16 (2) identify and evaluate all current and deferred maintenance needs for public 17 facilities, including their location, estimated costs, and the priority with which they should be 18 addressed; the task force shall coordinate with the University of Alaska, the principal state 19 departments, municipalities, the office of management and budget, and other affected entities 20 in order to ensure that the task force's work is as comprehensive and complete as possible;

21 (3) disseminate information and solicit public comment about its subject of 22 consideration;

23 (4) submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor and 24 the legislature by the convening of the Second Regular Session of the Twentieth Alaska State 25 Legislature concerning the current scope of deferred maintenance for public facilities and, to 26 the extent necessary, a plan for funding the expenses of the deferred maintenance needs 27 identified by the task force; and be it

28 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the task force may begin work immediately upon the 29 appointment of its full membership and is terminated upon the convening of the Second 30 Regular Session of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature.
