## A RESOLUTION

1 Relating to Step Family Day.

### 2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- **WHEREAS**, by the year 2000, according to the United States Bureau of the Census,
- 4 more than one-half of all Americans will be living in step families instead of nuclear families;
- 5 and
- **6 WHEREAS** step families provide loving relationships for thousands of Alaska parents
- 7 and children, enriching their lives and strengthening the fabric of our society; and
- **8 WHEREAS** the legislature believes that the invaluable contributions that step families
- 9 have made to our state and to our nation should be recognized throughout the year but
- 10 especially on a day set aside for step families in particular; and
- **WHEREAS** there is a nationwide movement to set aside September 16 as a special
- 12 day for recognition of the importance of step families in the United States;
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the
- 14 Governor to proclaim September 16 of each year as Step Family Day; and be it
- 15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges schools, religious
- 16 organizations, community groups, and other public and private agencies and individuals to
- 17 observe September 16 with appropriate activities that honor the role of step families in our
