A RESOLUTION

1 Relating to opposition to the designation of any rivers in Alaska as American
2 Heritage Rivers under the American Heritage Rivers initiative.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 WHEREAS the President of the United States has by Executive Order 13061 created
5 the American Heritage Rivers initiative; and

6 WHEREAS the initiative allows a local river community to nominate its river for
7 designation by the President as an American Heritage River; and

8 WHEREAS the initiative provides no meaningful protection of state or private
9 property along designated rivers; and

10 WHEREAS the initiative creates a new layer of federal bureaucracy and engages 12
11 federal agencies in its implementation;

12 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature opposes any attempt by the
13 federal government to further designate or label state property in Alaska or to further
14 federalize public land in Alaska; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature opposes the nomination or
16 designation of any river in Alaska as an American Heritage River under the American

1 Heritage Rivers initiative.

8 U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
