A RESOLUTION

- 1 Relating to support for Mitchell Field Adak airport.
- 2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- 3 WHEREAS the Mitchell Field Adak airport (Mitchell Field) is essential for providing
- 4 Instrument Flight Rules (IFR) air operation facilities to the communities of Atka and Shemya;
- 5 and
- **6** WHEREAS Adak's, Atka's, and Shemya's commercial and emergency services would
- 7 suffer without the continued availability of Mitchell Field; and
- **8 WHEREAS** Mitchell Field is critical to operations of the United States Air Force at
- 9 Eareckson Air Station Base; and
- WHEREAS saving lives and property depends on Mitchell Field being operated as a
- search and rescue center in the North Pacific, the Bering Sea, and the Western Aleutians; and
- WHEREAS Mitchell Field is essential for the reuse of over 1,000 structures on Adak
- 13 Island: and
- 14 WHEREAS Mitchell Field allows crew transfer services that would otherwise occur
- 15 in Vancouver, British Columbia, or Seattle, Washington to take place in Alaska; and
- WHEREAS operation of Mitchell Field allows increased Alaska fish sales to the
- 17 Orient and additional mining and oil and gas support to Eastern Russian; and

1	WHEREAS Mitchell Field provides an essential emergency jet airport for international
2	air carriers operating on over-the-pole flights; and
3	WHEREAS operation of Mitchell Field assists the federal government in fisheries
4	enforcement activities; and
5	WHEREAS there is currently a 22,000,000 gallon storage tank capacity at Adak,
6	making Adak a promising staging area for the fishing industry and the Pacific Fleet; and
7	WHEREAS Adak has existing housing facilities, roads, schools, a hospital, and other
8	utilities to support a community of at least 5,000 residents; and
9	WHEREAS the Adak Reuse Corporation needs the financial support of the United
10	States government and of the State of Alaska;
11	BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature requests that the Congress of
12	the United States appropriate to the Federal Aviation Administration the funds necessary to
13	keep the Mitchell Field Adak airport operational and maintained by the State of Alaska and
14	that the funds be provided to the Adak Reuse Corporation for these purposes.
