A RESOLUTION

1 **Establishing a House Special Committee on International Trade and Tourism.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

3 **WHEREAS** international trade and tourism are of increasing importance to the
4 economy of the state; and

5 **WHEREAS** the legislature should be well-informed about developments in
6 international trade and tourism in order to plan for the state's future; and

7 **WHEREAS** the state should promote tourism and enhance opportunities for visitors
8 to experience the life and scenic grandeur of the state; and

9 **WHEREAS** the state should promote and facilitate the export of the products and
10 services of the state;

11 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
12 on International Trade and Tourism is established to study issues relating to international trade
13 and tourism; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
15 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint
16 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

1 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on International Trade
2 and Tourism may meet during and between sessions of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature
3 and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-First Alaska State
4 Legislature.
