# A RESOLUTION

- 1 Establishing a House Special Committee on International Trade and Tourism.
- 2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- WHEREAS international trade and tourism are of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and
- 5 WHEREAS the legislature should be well-informed about developments in
- 6 international trade and tourism in order to plan for the state's future; and
- WHEREAS the state should promote tourism and enhance opportunities for visitors
  to experience the life and scenic grandeur of the state; and
- 9 WHEREAS the state should promote and facilitate the export of the products and
- 10 services of the state;
- 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
- 12 on International Trade and Tourism is established to study issues relating to international trade
- and tourism; and be it
- 14 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
- 15 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint
- 16 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

- 1 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on International Trade
- 2 and Tourism may meet during and between sessions of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature
- 3 and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-First Alaska State
- 4 Legislature.
