1 Establishing a House Special Committee on Oil and Gas.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

- 3 WHEREAS the state's dependence on oil revenue requires that the Alaska State
- 4 Legislature be well informed on all aspects of the state's oil and gas resources;
- 5 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
- 6 on Oil and Gas is established to study issues relating to oil and gas resources in the state; and
- 7 be it
- **8 FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
- 9 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint
- 10 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it
- 11 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Oil and Gas may meet
- during and between sessions of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on
- 13 the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-First Alaska State Legislature.
