**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Establishing a House Special Committee on Fisheries.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

3 **WHEREAS** fishing for personal use helps to define the Alaska lifestyle for many state  
4 residents; and

5 **WHEREAS** sport fishing plays a significant role in the state tourism industry; and

6 **WHEREAS** the commercial fishing industry is one of Alaska's largest renewable  
7 resource industries; and

8 **WHEREAS** Alaska's subsistence fisheries are an important use of our fisheries  
9 resources; and

10 **WHEREAS** the Alaska State Legislature must be well informed on all issues related  
11 to the fisheries of Alaska;

12 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee  
13 on Fisheries is established to study fishery issues relevant to Alaska; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
15 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee appoint the members  
16 and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

**1           FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Fisheries may meet  
**2** during and between sessions of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on  
**3** the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-First Alaska State Legislature.
