**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Establishing a House Special Committee on Telecommunications.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

3 **WHEREAS** telecommunications is of vital importance to the economy of the state;  
4 and

5 **WHEREAS** the legislature should remain well informed about the telecommunications  
6 industry of the state; and

7 **WHEREAS** the state must promote the efficient and orderly development of  
8 telecommunications within the state;

9 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee  
10 on Telecommunications is established to study telecommunications in the state and  
11 opportunities for the future development of telecommunications in the state; and be it

12 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall  
13 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint  
14 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

15 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the House Special Committee on Telecommunications  
16 may meet during and between sessions of the Twentieth Alaska State Legislature and is

- 1** terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-First Alaska State Legislature.
