A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to insurance covering an insured who is a victim of domestic
- 2 violence and requiring certain disclosures by an insurer."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. AS 21.36 is amended by adding new sections to read:
- Sec. 21.36.430. Insurance for domestic violence victims; records. (a) An
- 6 insurer offering insurance in this state may not (1) refuse to issue or renew insurance
- 7 coverage; (2) cancel an existing policy of insurance; (3) deny a covered claim; or (4)
- 8 increase the premium on an insurance policy if the refusal, cancellation, denial, or
- 9 increase results only from the fact that the person was a victim of domestic violence.
- 10 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section may not prevent an insurer from11 underwriting or rating
- 12 (1) for a medical condition, including a medical
 - (1) for a medical condition, including a medical condition resulting
- from domestic violence, in the same manner as it would for a person who is not a

victim of domestic violence; or

1	(2) a person based on known frequency of losses in the same manner
2	the insurer would for a person who is not a victim of domestic violence.
3	Sec. 21.36.440. Required disclosure for failure to provide coverage to an
4	applicant. An insurer who refuses to provide insurance coverage to an applicant
5	initially applying for insurance shall
6	(1) inform the applicant that the applicant has a right to know the
7	reason for the refusal; and
8	(2) upon receipt of a written request from the applicant, provide a
9	written explanation of the refusal to the applicant.
10	Sec. 21.36.450. Definition. In AS 21.36.430 - 21.36.440, "insurer" includes
11	(1) an insurer, as defined in AS 21.90.900;
12	(2) a group health plan, as defined in 29 U.S.C. 1167(1) (Employee
13	Retirement Income Security Act of 1974);
14	(3) a health maintenance organization, as defined in AS 21.86.900;
15	(4) a hospital service corporation or medical service corporation, as
16	defined in AS 21.87.330;
17	(5) the Comprehensive Health Insurance Association, established in
18	AS 21.55.010; and
19	(6) an entity offering a service benefit plan, as referred to in 42 U.S.C.
20	1396g-1.
21	* Sec. 2. This Act applies to a policy of insurance that is entered into or renewed on or
22	after the effective date of this Act.
