6 department may consider audit and inspection results and reports relating to the
7 facility.

9 Sec. 47.07.071. Reports by health facilities. <u>After</u> [NOT LATER THAN 120
10 DAYS AFTER] the end of each fiscal year of a health facility, the facility shall submit
11 to the department a report on the facility's financial performance during the fiscal year.
