**TWENTIETH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION**

**A RESOLUTION**

**1 Authorizing a recess by the Senate and the House of Representatives for a period**  
**2 of more than three days.**

**3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**4 WHEREAS** art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither  
**5 house may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other house concurs; and**

**6 WHEREAS** Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that  
**7 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house**  
**8 constitutes concurrence;**

**9 BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of  
**10 Representatives may be in recess during February 28, March 1, 2, 3, and 4 of 1997 and that**  
**11 each house concurs in this five-day recess by the other.**
