A RESOLUTION

- 1 Authorizing a recess by the Senate and the House of Representatives for a period
- 2 of more than three days.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- 4 WHEREAS art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither
- 5 house may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other house concurs; and
- **6** WHEREAS Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that
- 7 adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house
- 8 constitutes concurrence;
- **9 BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of
- 10 Representatives may be in recess during February 28, March 1, 2, 3, and 4 of 1997 and that
- 11 each house concurs in this five-day recess by the other.
