FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to controlled substances and to the possession of certain chemicals; and providing for an effective date." 2

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 11.71.020(a) is amended to read:

5 Except as authorized in AS 17.30, a person commits the crime of (a) 6 misconduct involving a controlled substance in the second degree if the person

7 (1) manufactures or delivers any amount of a schedule IA controlled 8 substance or possesses any amount of a schedule IA controlled substance with intent 9 to manufacture or deliver;

10 (2) manufactures any material, compound, mixture, or preparation 11 that contains

12 (A) methamphetamine, or its salts, isomers, or salts of 13 isomers; or 14

(B) an immediate precursor of methamphetamine, or its
