FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1	"An Act relating to transfer of a vehicle title by the owner; and providing for
2	an effective date."
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
4	* Section 1. AS 28.10.271(d) is amended to read:
5	(d) An emissions inspection and maintenance certificate
6	(1) shall be obtained when ownership of a [MOTOR] vehicle subject
7	to registration under this chapter is transferred [,] if the
8	$(\underline{\mathbf{A}})$ [(1)] transferee resides in an area designated by the
9	Department of Environmental Conservation as an emissions inspection and
10	maintenance area;
11	(B) [(2) MOTOR] vehicle was manufactured in 1987 or earlier;
12	(C) [(3) MOTOR] vehicle would be subject to an emissions
13	inspection and maintenance program; and
14	(D) [(4) MOTOR] vehicle has not been inspected for emissions

1	or the existing emissions inspection and maintenance certificate is more than
2	12 months old;
3	(2) need not be obtained under (1) of this subsection if, when
4	ownership of vehicle is transferred,
5	(A) the transferor surrenders the vehicle's registration plates
6	and all evidence of registration in the transferor's possession or control to
7	the department; or
8	(B) the vehicle has a valid, existing emissions inspection and
9	maintenance program seasonal waiver and the purchaser signs a seasonal
10	waiver transfer acknowledgment form approved by the department.
