- 4 Technology Foundation may award for development of the Kodiak launch complex
- 5 and Fairbanks satellite ground station space park; and providing for an effective
- 6 date."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- **8** * **Section 1.** AS 37.17.090(d) is amended to read:
- 9 (d) Except for grants awarded under (k) of this section and under
- AS 37.17.225, not less than 50 percent of the endowment income that is distributed
- to grantees by the foundation in a fiscal year must be for grant payments in that fiscal
- year of \$200,000 [\$100,000] or less, exclusive of other funding.
- * Sec. 2. AS 37.17.090(k) is amended to read:

l	(k) Subject to appropriation, the board may award the following grants:
2	(1) up to \$11,000,000 [\$5,000,000] to the Alaska Industrial
3	Development and Export Authority or the Alaska Aerospace Development Corporation
4	for the development of the Kodiak launch complex and Fairbanks satellite ground
5	station space park;
6	(2) up to \$4,000,000 to the Alaska Industrial Development and Export
7	Authority or to another entity satisfying criteria established by the board for research,
3	development, and commercialization of low-rank coal water fuel technology.
