A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska prohibiting
- 2 certain initiatives relating to wildlife.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * Section 1. Article XI, sec. 7, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:
- **Section 7. Restrictions.** The initiative shall not be used to dedicate revenues,
- 6 make or repeal appropriations, create courts, define the jurisdiction of courts or
- 7 prescribe their rules, permit, regulate, or prohibit the taking or transportation of
- 8 <u>wildlife, prescribe seasons or methods for the taking of wildlife,</u> or enact local or
- 9 special legislation. The referendum shall not be applied to dedications of revenue, to
- appropriations, to local or special legislation, or to laws necessary for the immediate
- preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
- * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of
- 13 the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the
- 14 State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
