A RESOLUTION

- 1 Establishing a House Special Committee on World Trade and State/Federal
- 2 Relations.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

- 4 WHEREAS world trade is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and
- 5 WHEREAS legislation enacted by the federal government has far reaching impact on
- **6** the economy of the state; and
- 7 WHEREAS there is renewed interest in the Congress of the United States in exploring
- 8 the ramifications of federal legislation on the states and their economies; and
- 9 WHEREAS the legislature should take an active role in exploring opportunities to
- 10 promote world trade and assist the Congress in understanding the effect of federal legislation
- 11 on the state's economy;
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
- 13 on World Trade and State/Federal Relations is established to study issues relating to world
- 14 trade and state/federal relations; and be it
- 15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
- 16 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint

- 1 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it
- 2 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on World Trade and
- 3 State/Federal Relations may meet during and between sessions of the Twenty-First Alaska
- 4 State Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-
- 5 Second Alaska State Legislature.
