A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a House Special Committee on Economic Development and Tourism.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

3 WHEREAS economic development is of vital importance to the economy of the state;
4 and

5 WHEREAS tourism is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

6 WHEREAS the legislature should remain well informed about the business climate
7 of the state; and

8 WHEREAS the state must promote business opportunities within the state;

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
10 on Economic Development and Tourism is established to study tourism and opportunities for
11 future economic development of the state's resources; and be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
13 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint
14 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Economic
16 Development and Tourism may meet during and between sessions of the Twenty-First Alaska
