A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing a House Special Committee on Oil and Gas.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

3 WHEREAS the state's dependence on oil revenue requires that the Alaska State
4 Legislature be well informed on all aspects of the state's oil and gas resources;

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that a House Special Committee
6 on Oil and Gas is established to study issues relating to oil and gas resources in the state; and
7 be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the House of Representatives shall
9 determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee and shall appoint
10 the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Oil and Gas may meet
12 during and between sessions of the Twenty-First Alaska State Legislature and is terminated
13 on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-Second Alaska State Legislature.
