A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to management of game."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3 * Section 1. AS 16.05.255 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

4 (i) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, in an area for which the
5 board has adopted regulations under (e) of this section to provide for intensive
6 management of an identified big game prey population by establishing a wolf control
7 program, a person may take a wolf on the same day the person was airborne; however,
8 a person may not shoot a wolf from the air under this subsection. For purposes of this
9 subsection, a valid hunting or trapping license is a permit to take a wolf on the same
10 day airborne for purposes of protecting wildlife, and no additional permit may be
11 required by the board or department as a prerequisite to taking a wolf on the same day
12 airborne.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.783(b) is amended to read:

14 (b) This section does not apply to

15 (1) a person who was airborne the same day if that person was airborne

- 1 only on a regularly scheduled commercial flight; or
- 2 (2) an employee or agent of the department who, as part of a game
- 3 management program, is authorized to shoot or to assist in shooting wolf, wolverine,
- 4 fox, or lynx on the same day that the employee or agent has been airborne.
