3 relating to the registration of voters; relating to election districts and officials;
4 relating to election procedures and ballots; relating to special procedures for
5 elections; relating to nomination of candidates; relating to national elections;
6 relating to special elections and appointments; relating to constitutional
7 amendments; relating to election offenses and corrupt practices; relating to election
8 pamphlets; relating to the deferral of jury service for certain election officials;
9 relating to an exemption from the State Procurement Code regarding election
10 ballots; relating to the provision and use of mailing addresses on permanent fund
11 dividend applications for election purposes; relating to the inclusion of voter
12 registration forms with permanent fund dividend applications; relating to financial
13 statements by public officials and candidates for public office; making conforming**

7 to qualifications of voters; relating to the registration of voters; relating to election districts
8 and officials; relating to election procedures and ballots; relating to special procedures for
9 elections; relating to nomination of candidates; relating to national elections; relating to special
10 elections and appointments; relating to constitutional amendments; relating to election offenses
11 and corrupt practices; relating to election pamphlets; relating to the deferral of jury service for
12 certain election officials; relating to an exemption from the State Procurement Code regarding
13 election ballots; relating to the provision and use of mailing addresses on permanent fund
14 dividend applications for election purposes; relating to the inclusion of voter registration forms
15 with permanent fund dividend applications; relating to financial statements by public officials
16 and candidates for public office; making conforming amendments in references to "election
17 district," "chairman," and similar terms; relating to initiative, referendum, and recall petitions.
