A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act eliminating a requirement that a social security number be provided by an
- 2 applicant for certain hunting or sport fishing licenses, tags, and permits; eliminating a
- 3 requirement that applications for certain licenses and tags be sworn to by the applicants
- 4 before an officer authorized to administer oaths; and providing for an effective date."

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 6 * Section 1. AS 16.05.360(a) is amended to read:
 - (a) The commissioner or an authorized deputy shall issue each license and tag to a qualified person under written application containing such reasonable information as required by the commissioner. The commissioner shall designate the license and tag form or type. The form or type must be sufficient to identify and locate the applicant and [,] establish the applicant's status as to residency and citizenship [, AND SUPPLY THE PERSON'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IF REQUIRED BY THIS CHAPTER]. Each application shall be subscribed [AND SWORN TO] by the applicant [BEFORE AN OFFICER AUTHORIZED TO ADMINISTER OATHS IN

- 1 THE STATE].
- 2 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.330(e), 16.05.346(d), and 16.05.360(b) are repealed.
- 3 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
