6	(b) An absentee ballot may not be counted if
7	(1) the voter has failed to properly execute the certificate;
8	(2) an official or the witnesses authorized by law to attest the voter's
9	certificate fail to execute the certificate, except that an absentee ballot cast in
10	person and accepted by an absentee voting official or election supervisor may be
11	counted despite failure of the absentee voting official or election supervisor to
12	properly sign and date the voter's certificate as attesting official as required
13	<u>under AS 15.20.061(c);</u>

14 (3) the ballot is not attested on or before the date of the election;

1	(4) the ballot, if postmarked, is not postmarked on or before the date of
2	the election; or
3	(5) after the day of election, the ballot was delivered by a means other
4	than mail.
