FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to brewpub licenses and to providing alcoholic beverages to a person
- 2 under 21 years of age."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- *** Section 1.** AS 04.11.135(a) is amended to read:
- 5 (a) A brewpub license authorizes the holder of a beverage dispensary license
- 6 to
- 7 (1) manufacture on premises licensed under the beverage dispensary
- license not more than <u>150,000</u> [75,000] gallons of beer in a calendar year;
- 9 (2) sell beer manufactured on premises licensed under the beverage
- dispensary license for consumption on the licensed premises or other licensed
- premises of the beverage dispensary licensee that are also licensed as a beverage
- dispensary;
- 13 (3) sell beer manufactured on the premises licensed under the beverage
- dispensary license in quantities of not more than five gallons per day to an individual
