4 (a) A person commits the crime of violating a protective order if the person is

5 subject to a protective order containing a provision listed in AS 18.66.100(c)(1) - (7)

6 and knowingly commits or attempts to commit an act **with reckless disregard that**

7 **the act violates or would violate a provision** [IN VIOLATION] of **the protective**

8 **order** [THAT PROVISION.]
